



# Augusta Cooperative Ingredient Standards

## CORN, YELLOW

**ACFB INGREDIENT NUMBER:** CORN  
CORNBULK  
CORNFINE  
CORNCOARSE  
RCORNBULK

**INTENDED USE:** As a nutritional ingredient in the manufacture of feed for livestock

**DEFINITION:** Yellow Corn shall be any grain that consists of whole kernels of yellow, shelled dent corn belonging to the family Zea mays

**PHYSICAL PROPERTIES:** **Color:** Yellow  
**Bulk Density:** 45 pounds per cubic foot

**ANALYSIS:**

Protein, min	7.0%
Fat, min	3.0%
Fiber, max	3.0%
Test Weight, min	54 lb/bu
Moisture, min	15.5%

**CRITERIA FOR REJECTION:** Not meeting any aspect of ingredient standards for U.S #2 grade  
Moisture or heat damage or color change indicative of damage  
Musty, rancid or sour odor  
Presence of foreign material or insect infestation  
More than 5% total damaged kernels

Note: Only CORNBULK is purchased, the other forms are processed in house.
